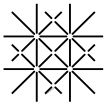
### Documents for a master's application with a bachelor's degree from a non-Swiss higher education institution (fall semester 2024)

The following list (see also page 2) contains all documents that must be uploaded for a master's application with a bachelor's degree from a non-Swiss higher education institution ([www.unibas.ch/application](http://www.unibas.ch/application)). Each file must be no larger than 20 MB.

The list distinguishes between documents that must be provided when submitting the application and documents that can be submitted by a later, specified deadline if not available at the time of application.
