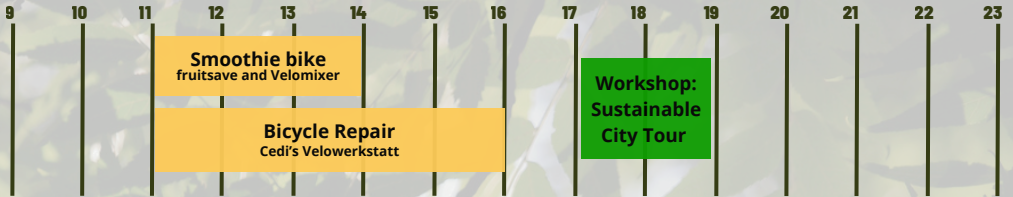
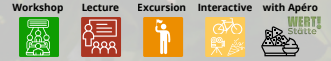

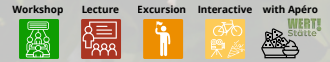
Creating High Impact Sustainable City Tours: Ideas, Tools and Practice. (EN)

Greenland and its role in the gathering geopolitical storm over access to the key resources of the future. (EN)

The lecture will examine Greenland as a pivotal "resource frontier" where the global demand for strategic minerals intersects with the shifting dynamics of Arctic sovereignty and the escalating climate crisis. It analyzes how Greenland's deposits of rare earth elements (REEs) and critical metals have positioned the island at the center of a "geopolitical storm" involving the United States, China, and the European Union. While international actors view Greenland as a solution to supply chain vulnerabilities, the discourse is often clouded by "resource myths" – overestimating the immediate feasibility of extraction while underplaying the ecological fragility of the Arctic. By linking these local environmental impacts to broader geopolitical debates, the analysis illustrates how Greenland serves as a micro-level laboratory for the clash between industrial necessity and sustainable preservation in a rapidly warming world.

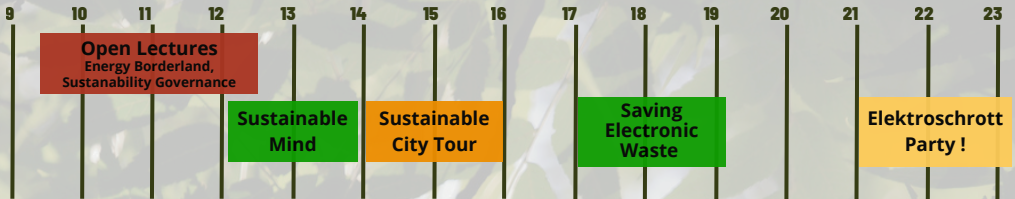
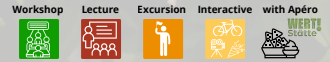

Energy Borderland – Cooperation and Competition in the Polish-Czech-German Border (EN)

The lecture examines the Polish–Czech–German borderland as an “energy borderland” shaped by both cooperation and competition around energy resources, infrastructure, and transition policies. It explores how coal legacies, energy security concerns, and divergent national strategies influence cross-border relations. Although EU frameworks encourage cooperation, unequal resource distribution, decarbonisation costs, and local environmental impacts generate ongoing tensions. The borderland thus serves as a micro-level laboratory showing how control over energy resources shapes political relations beyond the state, linking local dynamics to broader debates on security and cooperation in Europe’s transforming energy order.

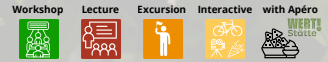

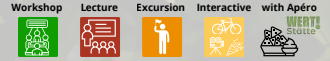

Future fuels and justice questions (EN)

In the EU (and mirrored in the revised CO2 act in Switzerland), mandatory sustainable aviation fuel (SAF) blending quotas are set to rise sharply from 2% today to 70% by 2050, forcing a critical confrontation between climate imperatives and societal equity. While promoted as a technical fix for aviation's carbon footprint, the transition to SAFs creates complex trade-offs involving resource competition, land-use and cost distribution, raising urgent questions of energy justice. Public perceptions of sustainable and alternative fuels such as SAFs and their alignment with principles of energy justice are critical to understanding the social acceptability and equitable deployment of these emerging technologies.

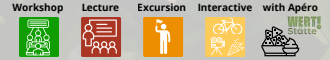
Sustainable Resource Management as a “quick fix” for Geopolitical Risks? (EN)

Drawing on current debates on resource security, climate policy, and global trade, we examine how policy makers, industry leaders, civil society and individuals can co-create strategies that align economic prosperity, social justice, and environmental integrity while mitigating both environmental damage and geopolitical risks

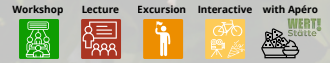
