



Information sheet: required documents for the application for master studies

This information sheet contains a list of the required documents for the application for master studies. Thus the documents can already be prepared before the online application (www.unibas.ch/application) is possible.

Please note that the required documents can only be submitted after completing the online application and along with the printout of the application form.

Required supporting documents:

The documents listed under 1), 2), and 3) must be enclosed **as officially authenticated copies and if required with a recognized translation**. (If you hold a degree from the University of Basel, it will be sufficient to provide simple copies.) Applicants are advised to take notice of the binding conditions for officially authenticated copies and recognized translations (www.unibas.ch/authentication).

- 1) Complete transcript with definitive final mark (transcript of records / relevé de notes etc.)
- 2) Diploma supplement (if issued by higher education institution)
- 3) Degree certificate of academic degree (Bachelor / Master / Diploma / Licentiate etc.)

Further required documents:

- 4) Current CV (Curriculum vitae) in tabular form
- 5) Copy of secondary school leaving certificate (for example: Maturität, Abitur, Baccalauréat, High School Diploma, Upper Secondary School Leaving Certificate etc.)
- 6) Copy of passport or national identity card (front page) – NOT residence permit (Ausländerausweis)
- 7) Copy of exmatriculation confirmation if you were matriculated at a Swiss higher education institution
- 8) Only candidates seeking admission to the specialized Master's programs in Infection Biology and Epidemiology are required to submit a letter of motivation.
- 9) Candidates seeking admission to the Master's program in Psychology: confirmation of university admission, if the Bachelor's degree is from a foreign higher education institution.
Candidates seeking admission to the Master's program in Business and Economics: confirmation of university admission, if the Bachelor's degree is from a foreign higher education institution and does not have a grade average of at least 5/unrounded or better according to the Swiss grading system (1–6, 6 = max. / 4 = pass).
