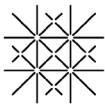

1. Application deadlines

In accordance with section 21 of the Student Regulations dated 13 November 2019, applicants commence the admission process once their application has been received by the corresponding deadline. The following application deadlines apply:

Late applications to bachelor's degree programs without admission restrictions

Late applications can be submitted to bachelor's degree programs without admission restrictions **until 31 July 2025 (fall semester) or until 5 January 2026 (spring semester)**, provided a corresponding request is submitted by the deadline with the required documents/information. If the required documentation is incomplete or requires in-depth checks and clarification, the request for late application will be rejected. In this case, the applicant is free to apply for a subsequent semester in accordance with the proper deadlines. If the request is approved, the online application must then be submitted with all the required documents by the deadline provided. An additional fee of CHF 150 is payable for late applications. There is no entitlement to the processing of a late application, nor can the right to admission be derived from the processing of a late application.

Late applications to master's degree programs without admission restrictions

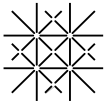
Late applications to master's degree programs (except for clinical medicine, dental medicine and nursing) are possible for holders of a recognized bachelor's level degree from a Swiss higher education institution **until 31 July 2025 (fall semester) or until 5 January 2026 (spring semester)**, provided a corresponding request is submitted by the deadline with the required documents/information. If the required documentation is incomplete or requires in-depth checks and clarification, the request for late application will be rejected. In this case, the applicant is free to apply for a subsequent semester in accordance with the proper deadlines. If the request is approved, the online application must then be submitted with all the required documents by the deadline provided. An additional fee of CHF 150 is payable for late applications. There is no entitlement to the processing of a late application, nor can the right to admission be derived from the processing of a late application.



Complementary Examination of the Swiss Universities (ECUS)

The following rules apply to candidates who are required to pass the Complementary Examination of the Swiss Universities (ECUS):

1. Candidates must apply for their desired bachelor's program at the University of Basel by the deadline (see application deadlines above). Application is only possible for the fall semester.
2. Once candidates have received their admission decision from the University of Basel, they must register by the deadline and pay the registration fee to the examination provider. The relevant deadlines are provided when the registration form is issued for the supplementary examination.



2. Admission to bachelor's studies with Swiss educational qualifications (academic year 2025/2026)

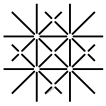
Swiss educational qualifications can be divided into the following admission categories:

- a) Access to all bachelor's degree programs
- b) Access to all bachelor's degree programs except medicine
- c) Access to all bachelor's degree programs at individual faculties

Study programs with restriction of admission remain subject to special requirements.

a) Access to all bachelor's degree programs is granted under the following conditions:

- Eidgenössische, bzw. schweizerische Maturität
- kantonale gymnasiale Maturität, die schweizerisch anerkannt ist (gemäss *Maturitätsanerkennungsreglement MAR* vom 16. Januar 1995 bzw. Verordnung über die Anerkennung von Maturitätsausweisen vom 22. Mai 1968)
- Abschlusszeugnis einer schweizerischen universitären Hochschule (Bachelor, Master, Lizentiat, Diplom, Staatsexamen). Nicht darunter fallen Abschlüsse der Weiterbildungsstufe (MAS, DAS, CAS, EMBA, Nachdiplome u. ä.).

- Bachelor einer schweizerischen Pädagogischen Hochschule, sofern der Studiengang gemäss dem von der Schweizerischen Konferenz der kantonalen Erziehungsdirektoren (EDK) publizierten Verzeichnis «EDK-anerkannte Diplome» am dort genannten Stichtag anerkannt ist. Nicht unter diese Regelung fallen Abschlüsse der Weiterbildungsstufe (MAS, DAS, CAS, EMBA, Nachdiplome u. ä.)
- Nachträglich erworbener schweizerischer FH-Titel, sofern ein entsprechender Entscheid der zuständigen Stelle vorliegt. Die alleinige Anerkennung für den Berufszugang ist nicht ausreichend.

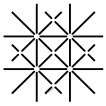

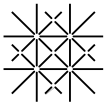

3. Admission to bachelor's studies with non-Swiss educational qualifications (academic year 2025/2026)

Non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificates are evaluated based on the “Recommendations for evaluating non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificates” adopted by the swissuniversities Chamber of Universities.

1. Recognition criteria for non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificates

Non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificates must largely correspond to the Swiss *Maturität* certificate and are therefore only recognized if the criteria listed in points 1.1—1.3 are cumulatively fulfilled. Non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificates from countries that are not signatories to the Lisbon Convention¹ (hereafter referred to as the Lisbon Convention) are subject to additional requirements (see point 3). These requirements are defined in the “list of countries” (see point 5).

1.1. Educational objective

A non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificate will be recognized with regard to its educational objective if the following criteria are fulfilled:

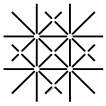
- a. The upper secondary level is specifically designed to prepare students to study at universities by providing a broad, balanced and coherent education and is not a subject-specific or vocational training at the same time.
- b. The secondary school leaving certificate that concludes the upper secondary level serves as a general higher education entrance qualification, granting the holder access to all university study programs in the higher education environment in the relevant country.
- c. The certificate also entitles the holder to admission to a study program at a state-recognized university within the education system of the relevant country (see also point 4 “Requirement for proof of admission”), with its curriculum being equivalent to the selected bachelor's degree program at the University of Basel.

1.2. Educational content

A non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificate will be recognized with regard to its educational content if the following criteria are fulfilled:

- a. Education at upper secondary level comprises at least 90% general education subjects; this is understood to mean subjects that, in essence, encompass content that is taught in the basic subjects, further compulsory subjects, major subjects and supplementary subjects that make up the Swiss *Maturität*.
- b. In the last three years of schooling at upper secondary level, at least six separately reported subjects that are independent of one another in accordance with the following “general education subject catalogue” have been consistently attended that fundamentally correspond to the relevant basic subjects or further compulsory subjects of the Swiss *Maturität* in terms of the academic level pursued, content taught and number of lessons per year:

- c. The study time for the subjects studied in the last three years of schooling at upper secondary level comprises at least the following percentages of overall teaching:

1.3. Period of study

A non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificate will be recognized with regard to the period of study if the following criteria are fulfilled:

- The holder's entire education (primary and secondary level) comprises at least twelve years, and
- upper secondary level education comprises at least three years.

2. Partial recognition of a non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificate from a signatory country of the Lisbon Convention

A non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificate from a country that has ratified the Lisbon Convention is partially recognized with regard to

- its educational content if, in the last three years of schooling at upper secondary level, five separately reported subjects that are independent of one another in accordance with the general education subject catalogue have been consistently attended,
- the period of study if the holder's entire education (primary and secondary level) comprises at least eleven years and upper secondary level education comprises at least two years.

The holder of such a partially recognized secondary school leaving certificate can then be admitted to a bachelor's program if

- the secondary school leaving certificate is recognized with regard to the educational objective stated in point 1.1,
- the secondary school leaving certificate is at least partially recognized with regard to its educational content according to point 1.2 and period of study in accordance with point 1.3, and
- documentation is provided of at least two successfully completed years of study (120 ECTS credit points) at a state-recognized university recognized by the University of Basel within the relevant education system in a subject area that is also offered at a Swiss university. The credits required for this documentation must either have been earned in accordance with a regular study plan for a full-time study program or credited to the desired qualification



within the relevant study program from a previous study program completed at the same or a different university recognized by the University of Basel.

3. Additional requirements for a non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificate from a country that is not a signatory of the Lisbon Convention

The following additional requirements apply for admission with a non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificate recognized in accordance with point 1 from a country that has not ratified the Lisbon Convention:

- a. A minimum overall grade stipulated in the “list of countries” must have been achieved for the degree, and
- b. the Complementary Examination of the Swiss Universities (ECUS) must be passed.

4. Requirement for proof of admission

If a non-Swiss secondary school leaving certificate grants a person access to university but does not automatically entitle them to admission to all university bachelor’s degree programs within the relevant national education system, evidence must be submitted of admission to a degree program at a state-recognized university in the relevant country that is equivalent to the intended bachelor’s degree program at the University of Basel. This evidence must be up to date and must not relate to a distance learning program or evening course.

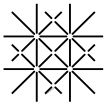
5. Country-specific admission requirements (list of countries)

A list arranged by country defines which educational qualifications permit access to all bachelor’s programs and which conditions apply (see “list of countries”). Secondary school leaving certificates are evaluated based on the criteria defined in points 1–4. Specific admission requirements with further stipulations (e.g. minimum grades, subject level) are defined for secondary school leaving certificates from certain countries that cannot be compared directly with the Swiss *Maturität* due to fundamental differences (e.g. United Kingdom, USA) and for the International Baccalaureate (see point 8).

The evaluation of a secondary school leaving certificate takes into account only school grades at upper secondary level that have been credited to the relevant certificate by the non-Swiss authorities responsible or school grades subsequently earned as a supplement to the relevant certificate that are recorded in a separate certificate.

The list of countries applies only for the relevant year of study. No transitional provisions are defined. Study programs with admissions restrictions remain subject to special requirements.

The Complementary Examination of the Swiss Universities (ECUS) is held just once per year in August. Therefore, corresponding applications are only possible for the fall semester, and not for the spring semester.



6. Further provisions

Not recognized are:

- In general, distance education school leaving certificates, night school leaving certificates and school leaving certificates not attained in a school class;
- Entrance examination certificates from foreign higher education institutions;
- Secondary school leaving certificates for upper secondary level education completed in various education systems. These certificates are recognized only if the last 3 years at upper secondary level are documented, all 3 years were passed and the “general education subject catalogue” was consistently fulfilled during these 3 years.

7. Baccalauréat Européen

The Baccalauréat Européen grants access to all bachelor's degree programs provided the requirements of the general education subject catalogue are fulfilled. Study programs with admissions restrictions remain subject to special requirements.

8. Admission with the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB)

The International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB) grants access to all bachelor's degree programs, providing a minimum of 32 out of 42 points is obtained (without bonus points / combined grade) in six subjects according to the following categories. One of the subjects in IB group 4 or 5 must have been taken at Higher Level. Degree programs with admissions restrictions remain subject to special requirements.

9. Recognition of degrees from foreign higher education institutions for admission

Applicants with degrees from a foreign higher education institution can be admitted to specific bachelor's degree programs independent of proof of a secondary school leaving certificate. The degree must be on the level of a bachelor's / master's degree or equivalent. The degree must have been conferred by a higher education institution recognized by the University of Basel and be deemed by the University of Basel to be equivalent to a corresponding degree from a Swiss higher education institution. This does not include continuing education qualifications. Study programs with admissions restrictions remain subject to special requirements.

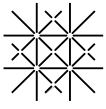

4. Recognized higher education institution / recognized higher education institution degree

Recognized higher education institution

A foreign higher education institution is recognized by the University of Basel

- if this recognition is stated in an agreement, a contract, or a binding arrangement with the Swiss Confederation or the University of Basel

or

- if it has been state-approved or accredited in the relevant education system and can award doctorates, meaning it has the right to offer academic doctorates (PhD) and confer the respective degree.

As a rule, a higher education institution and its degrees are not recognized if they fail to fulfil either of the above criteria. Higher education institutions in the USA (university or college) are recognized only if accredited by one of the following seven regional accreditation organizations: ACCJC, HLC, MSCHE, NECHE, NWCCU, SACSCOC, WSCUC.

In countries with education systems that make no institutional distinction between universities, universities of applied sciences, and universities for teacher education (1-pillar system), a degree is allocated to a type of higher education institution (university, university of applied sciences, university of teacher education) in accordance with the comparable degree program in the Swiss education system (2-pillar system).

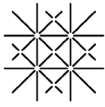
Recognized higher education institution degree

A higher education institution degree is only formally recognized if all of the following requirements are fulfilled:

- The academic degree/title has state recognition in the relevant educational system.
- The degree program is recognized/accredited by the official government agency in the respective educational system.
- The degree was conferred by a recognized higher education institution and at least 80% of the credits were obtained at a recognized higher education institution.
- The degree was earned at bachelor's/master's level or an equivalent level. Continuing education degrees (MAS, DAS, CAS, EMBA, postgraduate qualifications, etc.) are not recognized for admission.

A degree acquired through a distance learning program must fulfil the following additional requirements:

- The course achievements of the distance learning program are comparable with those of a corresponding on-campus program in the respective educational system.
- The degree achieved through the distance learning program must enable admission to further studies at the next educational level, including on-campus programs, in the respective educational system.



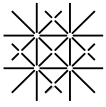
5. Special provisions governing the access of non-Swiss applicants to study medicine or dental medicine

Special provisions govern the access of non-Swiss applicants to the Bachelor's in Medicine as well as the Master's in Medicine and Master's in Dental Medicine in addition to the general requirements (in accordance with the recommendations of the Higher Education Council on Admission of Foreign Nationals to Medical Studies in Switzerland of 27 February 2020).

- I. Access to the Bachelor's in Medicine and to the Master's in Medicine and Master's in Dental Medicine is available to:
 - a. citizens of the Principality of Liechtenstein;
 - b. foreign nationals who hold a Swiss or Principality of Liechtenstein settlement permit;
 - c. foreign nationals who are citizens of a Member State of the European Union, Iceland or Norway and who hold a Swiss residence permit for EU/EFTA citizens with the note "gainful employment", provided that the applicant has spent at least one year working in Switzerland in a professional capacity closely related to the desired medical studies (Annex I, section 9 para. 3 of the EU-CH Bilateral Agreement on the Free Movement of Persons, AFMP, SR 0.142.112.681). The professional activities considered to be closely related to the study of medicine in Switzerland are listed in section 2 of the Federal Act on University Courses for Medical Professions (Medical Professions Act, MedPA, SR 811.11);
 - d. children from any nation whose parents are citizens of a Member State of the European Union, Iceland, Norway or the Principality of Liechtenstein provided that the applicant holds a Swiss residence permit issued to family members of an EU/EFTA citizen with the note "family reunification" (in accordance with the AFMP, Annex I, section 3 para. 6);
 - e. foreign nationals resident in Switzerland in accordance with sections 23 to 26 of the Swiss Civil Code (CC, SR 210) who satisfy one of the following criteria:
 1. They have held a Swiss residence permit with the note to indicate the main purpose of residency as "gainful employment" for an uninterrupted period of at least five years or
 2. they hold a nationally recognized Swiss or cantonal Maturität certificate (Ordinance of 15 February 1995 on the Recognition of Baccalaureates and EDK Regulation of 16 January 1995 on the Recognition of Baccalaureates) or
 3. they hold one of the following qualifications:
 - federal vocational baccalaureate (eidgenössisches Berufsmaturitätszeugnis)
 - Liechtenstein vocational baccalaureate (Berufsmaturitätszeugnis) recognized by the State Secretariat for Education, Research and Innovation (SERI)
 - specialized baccalaureate (Fachmaturitätszeugnis) recognized at national level in Switzerland,
combined with evidence of having passed the University Aptitude Test (UAT) (Ordinance of 2 February 2011 on the University Aptitude Test for Holders of Federal Vocational Baccalaureates or Nationally Recognised Specialised Baccalaureates for Admission to Swiss Tier-One Universities, SR 413.14) or
 4. they are the spouse or registered same-sex partner of a Swiss citizen or
 5. they are the spouse or registered same-sex partner of a foreign national who holds a Swiss settlement permit or



6. they are the spouse or registered same-sex partner of a foreign national who has held a Swiss residence permit with the note to indicate the main purpose of residency as "gainful employment" and resided in Switzerland for an uninterrupted period of at least five years.
 - f. Foreign nationals who have resided in Switzerland for the past two years in accordance with sections 23 to 26 of the Swiss Civil Code (CC, SR 210) and satisfy one of the following criteria:
 1. One of both parents hold a Swiss settlement permit or
 2. One of both parents have resided in Switzerland and have held a Swiss residence permit with the note to indicate the main purpose of residency as "gainful employment" for an uninterrupted period of at least five years.
 - g. Foreign nationals whose parents hold diplomatic status in Switzerland (type B, C or D blue legitimation card issued by the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs).
 - h. Foreign nationals who are recognized as refugees in Switzerland.
- II. The following conditions apply:
- a. The reference date for determining eligibility is the date stipulated by swissuniversities as the closing date for submission of applications for medical studies.
 - b. The foreign nationals referred to in para. 1 let. a to h must submit the documents entitling them to apply for admission no later than the application closing date. The university entrance qualifications mentioned in para. I let. e no. 2 and 3 may be submitted later.



6. Conversion and calculation of final grade

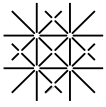
The conversion of the final grade / grade average of degrees awarded by foreign higher education institutions into the Swiss grading system follows the subsequent formula: [The result is rounded to one decimal place.]

$$y = 6 - 2 \cdot \left(\frac{N_{\max} - N_{\text{trans}}}{N_{\max} - N_{\min}} \right)$$

<i>y</i> :	result, rounded to one decimal place
6:	highest grade in the Swiss grading system
2:	conversion factor
<i>N_{max}</i> :	highest grade in the foreign grading system
<i>N_{trans}</i> :	the final grade that has to be converted into the Swiss grading system
<i>N_{min}</i> :	lowest pass grade (on average) in the foreign grading system

This conversion formula is only binding for the admission process to all levels of degree courses (bachelor, master, doctorate) and can only be used for absolute, not for relative scales. The faculties may use different conversion formulas for the recognition of foreign course achievements.

If the higher education institution in question does not report a final grade, the University of Basel calculates the weighted final grade from all graded assessments listed in the transcript of records from the relevant institution that were credited as part of the degree. The individual grades and/or module grades – if recorded – are hereby included in the weighted final grade in accordance with the weight of the credit points allocated. The final grade calculated is not rounded up or down.

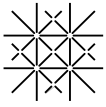


7. Additional requirements for the admission to master's studies

In addition to the requirements of the student regulations dated from 13 November 2019 of the University of Basel, the following requirement has to be fulfilled in order to qualify for the admission to master's studies on the basis of a degree awarded by a foreign higher education institution recognized by the University of Basel:

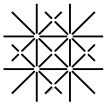
- The proof of a place to study in the respective system of higher education has to come from a university recognized by the University of Basel and cannot be issued for a distance learning program or evening classes. It must be current.

If official confirmation of completion of the bachelor's degree (including a complete degree transcript with detailed record of achievement and definitive final grade) is not yet available when the admission letter is issued, the applicant can be admitted on the condition that the missing documents are submitted by a deadline set by the Student Administration Office. Admission will be revoked if the outstanding documents are not submitted by the deadline or if it transpires that the admission requirements have not been fulfilled. Conditional offers cannot be given for the restricted-admission master's degree programs in the Faculty of Medicine.



8. Supplementary provisions on non-admission in the event of existing exclusion

In accordance with the provisions of section 13 paragraph 2 (a) of the student regulations of the University of Basel, dated 13 November 2019, admission will not be granted to anyone who has been definitively excluded from further study or is no longer permitted to continue their studies in a comparable degree program or degree subject at a Swiss or non-Swiss higher education institution. If a person has been excluded from a bachelor's program, they cannot be subsequently admitted to a corresponding consecutive master's program or a specialized master's program that builds on this bachelor's program. This also applies if this person has, in the meantime, earned a degree from another higher education institution.



9. Supplementary provisions on admission with a degree from the University of Basel awarded under a former system of regulations

A degree awarded under a former system of regulations (e.g. a *lizentiat/licentiate* or *diplom/diploma*) from the University of Basel entitles the holder to admission to a degree program or doctoral studies at the University of Basel only if all currently applicable admission requirements are fulfilled as set out in the relevant study regulations or doctoral study regulations; in particular, the grade awarded must fulfil the current average grade requirements.

If the degree awarded under a former system of regulations was not assigned an average grade and the average grade cannot be calculated, the relevant committee will determine whether the degree is equivalent to the average grade required. Applicants are not entitled to admission based on a Latin grade earned under a former system of regulations.



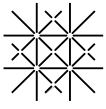
10. Language skills

According to section 14 of the student regulations dated 13 November 2019 the two principal languages of instruction at the University of Basel are German and English.

The corresponding language skills are prerequisites for the successful completion of a degree program. The language of instruction in bachelor's degree programs, but also in some master's degree programs, is predominantly German. German is also the principal examination language, both in written and in oral examinations. To successfully pursue their chosen degree course, students are advised to have attained language skills at Level C1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages before the beginning of their degree program. The same also applies to English for those master's degree programs taught primarily in English.

Students are responsible for having attained the language skills required to successfully pursue their chosen degree program. Examination failures cannot be excused by insufficient language skills.

The Language Centre of the University of Basel helps students acquire language skills at the necessary level (www.sprachenzentrum.unibas.ch).



11. Certified translations

If original documents are in a language other than German, French, Italian or English, a certified translation in German or English is required. The following provisions apply to certified translations:

General requirements

- The translation must be based on either the original document or an officially certified copy.
- Foreign diplomas, academic degrees and titles, names of higher education institutions and universities as well as names of schools must be translated literally with the original name or term included in parentheses after the respective translation.
- The translation must include a written confirmation from the translator (in German or English) affirming the accuracy of the translation along with the translator's last name, first name and contact information for any follow-up questions.
- The translation must be prepared by a translator who holds the necessary qualifications. The translator may be required to produce proof of these qualifications. Translations produced by the applicant or by private individuals are not considered certified and will not be recognized by the University of Basel.

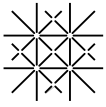
Additional requirements for translations from outside Switzerland

Translations from outside Switzerland are recognized only if:

- The translation was produced by the institution that issued the original document.
- The translation was produced by a sworn translator whose signature has been notarized by one of the following:
 - Consular or diplomatic representative of the Swiss Federation or another state.
 - An authority entitled to verify documents in accordance with the Hague Apostille Convention of 5 October 1961.
- A "Verification Report" from the Center for Student Services and Development (CSSD) will be accepted for Chinese higher education institution degrees and associated transcripts of academic records. See: <https://www.chsi.com.cn/en/pvr/>

Further provisions

The University of Basel retains the right to verify the authenticity of the documents submitted with the issuing institution directly as well as to reject flawed translations and have their accuracy checked by an internal University of Basel body. Furthermore, in cases of doubt the applicant may be required to supply confirmation of the accuracy of the translation at their own expense from a second authority.



12. Supplementary requirements for admission to the joint Master's Degree in Subject-Specific Teaching and Learning

Admission to the joint Master's Degree in Subject-Specific Teaching and Learning, offered by the Institute for Educational Sciences at the University of Basel in conjunction with the FHNW School of Education, may deviate from the list of formally recognized qualifications of the Swiss Conference of Cantonal Ministers of Education (EDK) (see published directory: <https://edudoc.ch/record/216047/files/PH-Diplome-Registre-d-f.pdf>) for formal degree recognition provided the following (cumulative) requirements are met:

1. Tertiary-level degree program lasting at least 3 years at a higher education institution recognized by the canton
2. EDK decision regarding Switzerland-wide recognition for entry to a profession
3. Confirmation from the successor institution that the content and academic level of the qualification earned is equivalent to the relevant diploma recognized by the EDK according to the published directory
4. Average grade of at least 5 / unrounded in accordance with Section 17 of the student regulations of the University of Basel dated 13 November 2019

This does not include courses such as the two-year training programs for teachers formerly offered by the Pädagogisches Institut Basel-Stadt and the Kantonale Lehrerinnen- und Lehrerseminar Basel-Landschaft, as well as general teaching diplomas.
