Public transport:

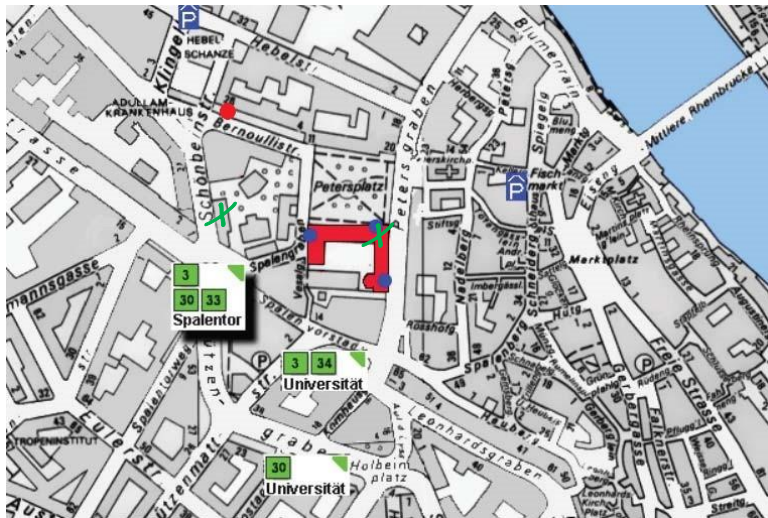
