

## Information sheet Documents for an online doctorate application

The following list contains all documents that must be uploaded for an online doctorate application ([www.unibas.ch/application](http://www.unibas.ch/application)). Each file must be no larger than 20 MB. In addition to the documents required for all doctorates (*all faculties/institutes*), specific *additional documents* may be required depending on the faculty. The list distinguishes between documents that must be provided when submitting the application and documents that can be submitted by a later, specified deadline if not available at the time of application.

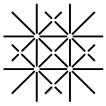
Original documents created in a language other than German, French, Italian, or English are to be uploaded together with a **certified translation** in German or English (no translation required for a *Maturität* or secondary/high school leaving certificate). 1. Declaration of consent (download from the online application area)	PDF	Compulsory

5. * Higher education institution degree relevant to admission (degree transcript/transcript of records, degree certificate, diploma supplement). This is usually the master's degree.	PDF	Can be submitted later if not yet available
6. Academic transcript for current studies (if higher education institution degree relevant to admission has not yet been completed)	PDF	Compulsory
7. Bachelor's degree certificate and degree transcript/transcript of records (if applicant holds a bachelor's degree)	PDF	Compulsory where available
8. <i>Maturität</i> / secondary/high school leaving certificate (if applicant holds such a certificate)	PDF	Compulsory where available
9. Confirmation of exmatriculation, if applicant has already matriculated at another Swiss higher education institution	PDF	Can be submitted later

\* If degree certificate / degree transcript/transcript of records / diploma supplement are only available at a later date, an official degree confirmation will be accepted (including a complete degree transcript/transcript of records with definitive final grade).

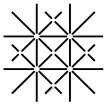
