## Information sheet Documents for a doctorate application

The following list contains all documents that must be uploaded for a doctorate application (<a href="www.uni-bas.ch/application">www.uni-bas.ch/application</a>). Each file must be no larger than 20 MB. In addition to the documents required for all doctorates (all faculties/institutes), specific additional documents may be required depending on the faculty. The list distinguishes between documents that must be provided when submitting the application and documents that can be submitted by a later, specified deadline if not available at the time of application. Original documents created in a language other than German, French, Italian, or English are to be uploaded together with a certified translation in German or English (no translation required for a Maturität or secondary/high school leaving certificate).
