The Grants Office is the central contact point for national and international funding programmes, providing advice and support to researchers from the University of Basel and University Hospitals.



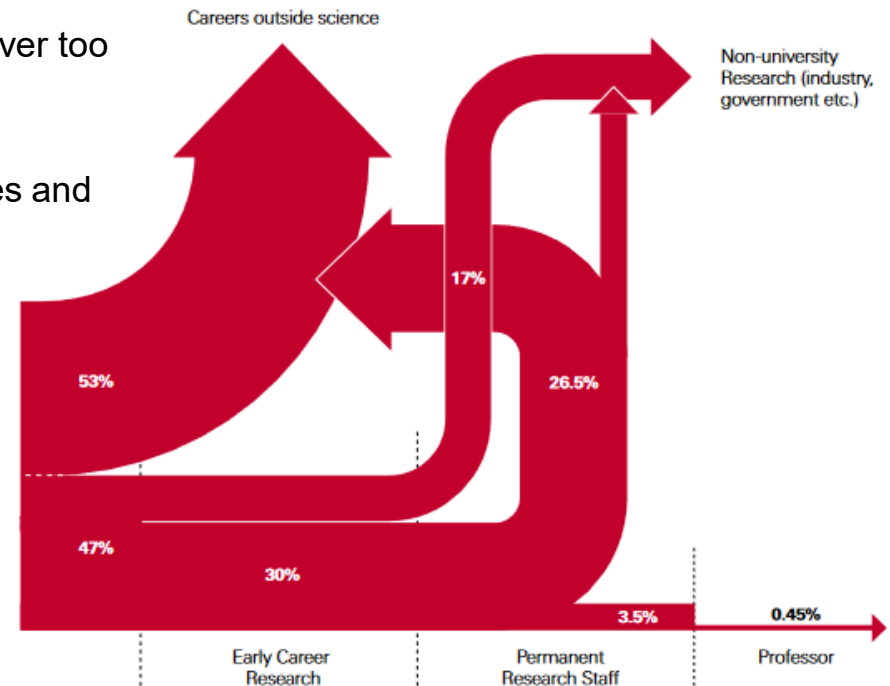

Various people and organizational units from across the university provide services for researchers throughout all the steps in the life cycle of data. Close collaboration between them within a strong network is essential to ensure efficient and optimal support for researchers.

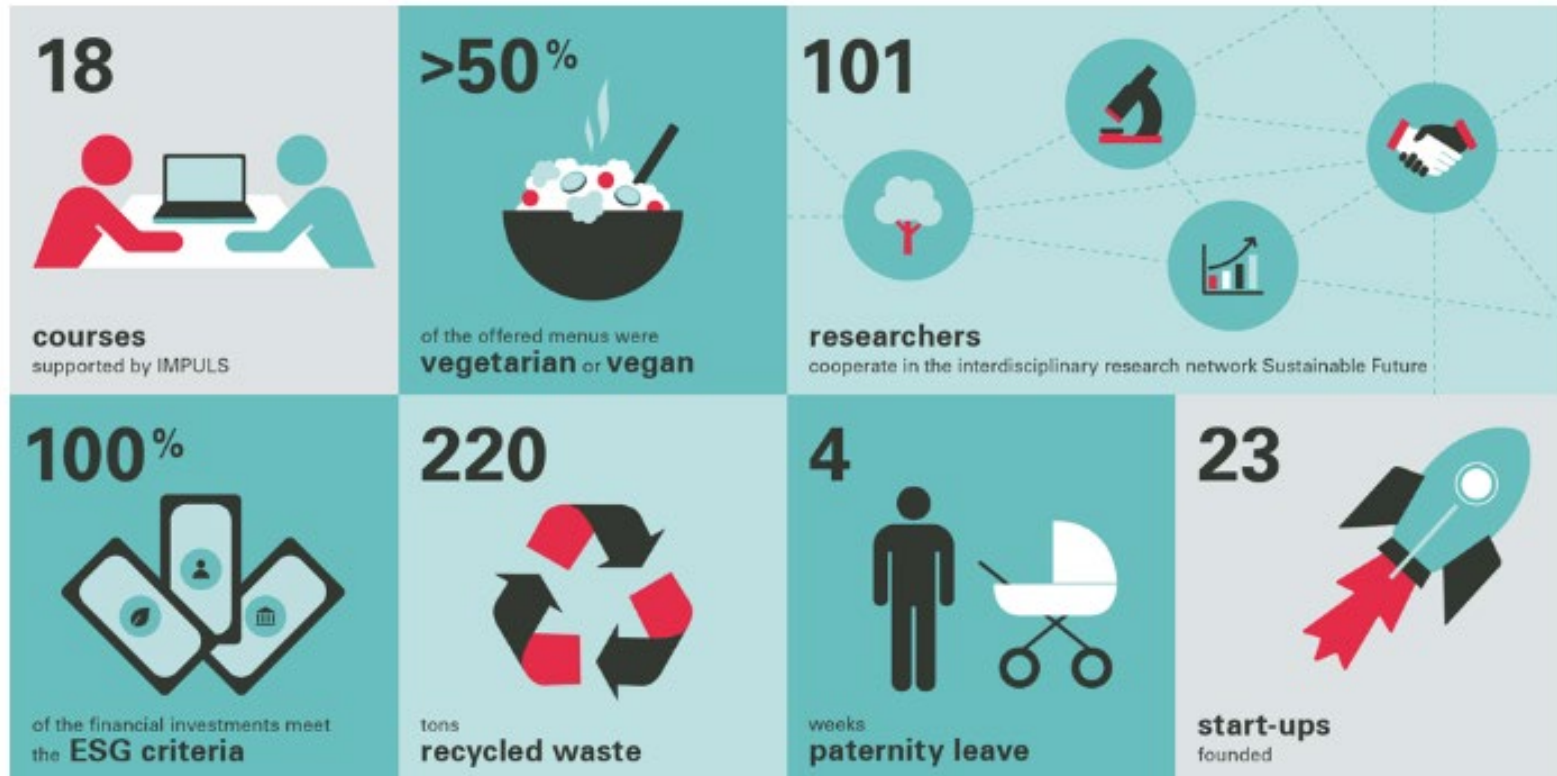


- A large proportion of the University of Basel's total greenhouse gas emissions are caused by air travel.
