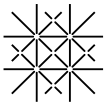

<p>With "get on track", mothers and fathers doing a PhD have the possibility to apply for an exemption contribution per child for one semester (child care; student assistant). In the case of maternity, you are entitled to a leave of 16 weeks on full salary. During compulsory Swiss military, civilian and fire protection services, the full salary is paid. Contact is the decentralized/centralized HR.</p> <p>If the employment contract ends during the above-mentioned absences, the pro rata compensation from the insurance will be paid to the assistant. If no substitute is employed during maternity leave or military service, the assistant may request an extension of the contract to compensate the lost research time as a result of the absence, without incurring costs and at least with the daily allowance from the insurance. During this time, the assistant is also entitled to his/her workplace.</p>
