



Contributions for junior scientific retreats at the University of Basel

Guidelines

The Rectorate of the University of Basel took note of the following guidelines on 10 January 2023:¹

Purpose

The Rectorate of the University of Basel provides an annual contribution to enable the organization of junior scientific retreats. Support is provided for disciplinary and interdisciplinary, internal university, national and international junior scientific retreats as well as specific junior researcher conferences, e.g. doctoral conferences with the involvement of external experts.

Condition

The condition for applying for a financial contribution is the proven contribution of doctoral students and postdocs (lectures/presentations, co-presentations to keynote speeches, organization and realization of panels, workshops, etc.).

Contributions

Funding can be requested for the costs of organization and implementation, for expenses and fees of external speakers. A maximum of CHF 10'000 can be requested per event. It is expected that additional third-party funds will be raised.

Eligibility

Doctoral and postdoctoral students of all faculties of the University of Basel who organize and carry out a specific event for junior researchers are eligible to apply.

Applications must be submitted digitally in advance by 01.02. and 01.10. using the designated form (see above) to: nachwuchsfoerderung@unibas.ch

Award

Applications are processed and decided upon twice a year by the Vice President for Research.

There is no legal entitlement to a grant.
