



Compulsory Matriculation for Course Achievements and Exams

1. Decision of the Rectorate from 13 November 2007

On 13 November 2007 the Rectorate declared the regulations developed at the plenary session of the Rectors' Conference of the Swiss Universities (CRUS) on 8-9 March 2007, concerning *Deadlines for Course Achievements and Exams before/immediately after the Semester End* as binding for the University of Basel, valid from the fall semester 2007. The amendment “[or individuals]” in item c represents the University of Basel's decision for a more generous interpretation.

- a. Course Achievements (including final examinations at the bachelor's and master's level as well as bachelor's and master's theses) are always connected to a specific semester.
- b. Course Achievements must always be completed and documented before the end of the semester (31 July or 31 January).
- c. Examinations set later for an entire cohort [or individuals] due to the program structure must be taken and documented before week 38 or 8. The same applies for repeat exams.
- d. Students must be matriculated at the respective university up until the exams are completed or until they have earned any missing credit points.
- e. From week 38 or 8, missing credit points can only be earned by students who are registered for the respective semester and who have paid fees.

2. Implementation and practical examples

If missing credit points are earned or performance examinations are taken from 01 March 2021 (beginning of the lecture period for the spring semester 2021), or written assignments have not yet been graded, it is necessary to re-enroll for the spring semester 2021 (CHF 850.-). The following table provides information on the dates by which performance exams (bachelor's exams, master's and diploma theses etc.) must be completed and graded so that re-enrollment for the subsequent semester is not required.
